

Step 1:

Ensure that you are running the Firefox Web Browser. If not, download it...



Step 2:

Go to www.downloadhelper.net and install the add-on by clicking "install the Extension"

DownloadHelper is also a **free Firefox extension** for **downloading** and **converting** videos from many sites with **minimum effort**. Install the extension !

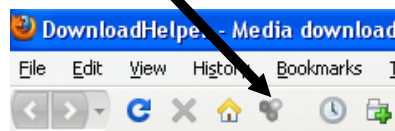

You will see the Downloadhelper icon on your toolbar. It will be gray when inactive.



If it is colored and spinning, the add-on is recognizing media on the web page. A drop down menu will also appear to the right.



Step 4:

Click on the drop down arrow (not the spinning icon!) and you will see a menu of download options. Choose the option that starts with the highlighted logo...



Choose where to save the file - usually the desktop

Step 5:

Open SMART Notebook software

Insert the video by dragging and dropping it from the desktop onto the work area

or

Go to "Insert" menu and choose
Flash Video File

You can resize or lock your video
Don't forget to **SAVE YOUR FILE!**
